


Article Galaxy Bulk Ordering

Order Multiple Articles In Seconds, All In One Streamlined Workflow




Stop ordering articles one at a time. Article Galaxy's bulk ordering feature lets you add up to 50 articles to your cart at once, filter by intended use, and download PDFs together, transforming how you access and manage research literature.

Two Ways To Add Articles In Bulk

Paste Identifiers


Simply copy and paste up to 50 DOIs or PubMed IDs into the search bar. Article Galaxy automatically recognizes and encapsulates each identifier with no manual formatting required.

Drag & Drop Reference Files


Upload reference manager files (RIS, NBIB, BibTeX) directly into the search interface. Your articles populate instantly, ready to review and order.



Supported formats: RIS, NBIB, BibTeX

Smart Filtering By Intended Use

After searching, filter your results by intended use to see which articles are available under your specific access rights, all before adding to your cart.




Once your order is placed, immediately available PDFs display "Open PDF" buttons for instant download.




